



4th Seminar on High Quality Surgery and Medicine in War Torn and in Low Income Areas

Emergency organizes the 4th Seminar on High Quality Surgery and Medicine in War Torn and in Low Income Areas in Venice, Italy.

Date: May, 18th-19th 2018

Venue: Emergency – Giudecca 212, 30133 VENICE

The aim of the seminar is to provide participants with the basic principles of the treatment of patients in low income and in war-torn Countries.

Participation to the seminar is open to professionals with little or no experience in practising in low income Countries.

The seminar is intended to be preparatory to any professional (Anaesthetists, Cardiologists and Cardiac Surgeons, Emergency Medicine Doctors, Laboratory Technicians, General and Orthopaedics Surgeons, Internal Medicine Doctors, Obstetricians, Gynaecologists and Midwives, Paediatricians and Neonatologists, Perfusionists, Physiotherapists) willing to join the Emergency team.

Seminar schedule will be organized as follows: on Day 1 (Friday May, 18th), all participants will attend a plenary session presenting an overview of Emergency's activities, hospital organization and the basic medical and nursing principles of patient treatment; on Day 2 (Saturday May, 19th), each participant will attend specific sessions focusing on the particular techniques and clinical management peculiar to his/her speciality. Emergency personnel with great field experience will give all the lectures.

Official language of the seminar is English and seats are limited.

The selection of attendees will be based on candidates' profiles and CV, previous professional and humanitarian experiences and commitment to work with Emergency.

The Seminar will be accredited with CME credits.

The cost of the seminar is 350€ for General, Cardio and Orthopaedic Surgeon, Anaesthetist, Internal Medicine Doctor, Emergency Medicine Doctor, Cardiologist, Obstetrician, Gynaecologist and Paediatrician; 200€ for Midwife, Physiotherapist, Laboratory Technician, Perfusionist and Nurse; 100€ for Resident. The fee includes CME credits, all scientific documents and meals.

Participants are responsible for traveling costs to-from Venice as well as accommodation arrangements.

Enrolment fees will be entirely devoted to the seminar organization.
